## The verb querer

- To say what you or others want, use a form of the verb **querer**.
- The form you use depends on the subject.

yo	qu <b>ie</b> ro	nosotros(as)	queremos
tú	qu <b>ie</b> res	vosotros(as)	queréis
Ud., él, ella	qu <b>ie</b> re	Uds., ellos, ellas	qu <b>ie</b> ren

## Querer with a noun or infinitive

- Just as with **gustar**, you can use a **noun** or an **infinitive** after a form of the verb **querer** to say what you and others *want* or *want to do*.

**Quiero fruta.**

*I want some fruit.*

¿Que **quieres hacer**?

*What do you want to do?*

**Quiero comer.**

*I want to eat.*

**Quiero escuchar** música.

*I want to listen to music.*
